




FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE

Anorexia.

Depression.

Fever.

Lameness.

Reduced milk.

Salivation.

Vesicles and lesions.

RECOGNIZING THE DISEASE

Lesions in the interdigital space, often accompanied by lameness.

sheep and goats clinical signs are often mild and can be harder to

notice.



Increased salivation and mouth lesions.
