### RECOGNIZING THE DISEASE



Abortion & sudden death in neonates.

Anorexia.

Depression.

Fever.

Lameness.

Reduced milk.

Salivation.

Vesicles and lesions.

In sheep and goats clinical signs are often mild and can be harder to notice.

Lesions in the interdigital space, often accompanied by lameness.



Increased salivation and mouth lesions.
